

Before you say yes, you might have a few questions to ask. . . .

How can you help us?

You can partner with Community Aid and we can serve our community together by allowing us to place a clothing bin on your property.

Are we a registered Charity?

Yes, we have registered with the state of Pennsylvania and have been approved by the IRS as a 501 (C)(3) charitable organization.

What happens to the clothing collected?

We will sell the donated clothing in our thrift stores located in Mechanicsburg and Hanover, PA. All items will be sold at the most affordable price to allow our neighbors a place where they can shop and buy what they need for their families. We will supply Partner organizations with FREE clothing vouchers to issue to those who need a helping hand! Excess goods will be baled and sold to overseas companies. All the income generated helps our neighbors in need and provides affordable clothing in needy countries.

How often are the bins serviced?

If needed every day. In most cases a minimum of four (4) days a week. Unlike other collectors, we live here and care about our community.

Do we carry liability insurance?

Yes, if requested a certificate of liability insurance is issued for any bin location.

What if I want the bin removed?

Just call us; usually we will remove within 48 hours.

Why should I allow a bin at my location?

First, our bins will show the public that your business is involved in our community. Second, our bins will generate more traffic, which will lead to more customers. However, the most important reason is that we want to become a source of income for helping our neighbors in need and having you partner with us in getting this new charitable work started. Currently we have begun Partnering with some local churches, and non-profit charitable organizations which a direct cash donation can be received from the net proceeds of clothing collected at your site. You decide who you want to help. Choose your favorite faith based charity, 501(C)(3) charity or keep the proceeds for your own charity, church or faith-based organization. Helping made simple!
