

Camp Counselor Description and Guidelines

Location	Black Rock Retreat Center, Quarryville, PA
Position Title & Requirements Purpose	Camp Counselor, PA-TSA Family Camp Minimum age for consideration is 20, unless candidate has successfully completed our Junior Youth Mentor program and is at least 18 years old. Other exceptions may be made. Once hired, State Police, Childline Child Abuse History Clearances must be on file with PA-TSA, as well as any other additional clearances required by PA law. To energize, interact with, offer acceptance and supervise the youth. To lead group in activities and/or support activities being led by camp staff.
Key Responsibilities	Offer acceptance and supervise the youth during most daytime activities on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Camp Counselors will be assigned to a small group of youth and will work with them throughout the weekend. Some groups will have 2 counselors assigned. Each group may also have a volunteer youth mentor and/or Junior youth mentor to assist. Most activities are led by camp staff. The counselors are there to engage, supervise and care for the campers. They are responsible for the overall safety and welfare of the campers assigned to them.
Time Commitment	Arrival should be no later than Friday at 2PM. Camp Counselors are expected to stay on site and help through Sunday at 12PM. It is pertinent that the Counselors be committed to attending the entire weekend and completing all duties as assigned. Volunteer youth mentors, will sometimes come in and out of the groups as needed or as their time allows. Counselors, however, will be committed to leading the groups for the duration of Camp.
Relationships	Works with other camp counselors, volunteer youth mentors, camp staff and PATSA staff to ensure a safe and fun time for the Camp attendees.
Reports to or Partners with	Reports to PA-TSA staff
Training & Development Opportunities	Camp Counselor, Internet training, must be viewed 1 to 2 weeks prior to the date of camp. All camp counselors will be given a detailed schedule, group member names/info, and responsibilities list upon their arrival at camp.
Compensation Details	Compensation will be a weekend stipend of \$100.00 and free camp registration. Registration includes sleeping accommodations, all meals, and a camp T-Shirt.
