COMMUNITY PRESENTATIONS

The Pennsylvania Tourette Syndrome Alliance provides a Community Presentation on Tourette Syndrome that can be tailored to meet the needs of any age group. The presentation is approximately 1 hour in length and focuses on Tourette Syndrome, the common associated disorders and how to assist someone affected by TS. Presenters offer many real-life examples gained from their professional and personal experience with those affected by Tourette Syndrome.

Presentation includes:

- Power point (*Equipment provided at location or brought by staff*)
- Excerpt from a TS film
- Handouts as appropriate
- Interactive activity for attendees to experience “having a tic”
- Question and Answer session

If presenting to a child’s Peer group (ie, scouts, sports teams, place of worship, etc,) the following information can also be included:

- A general dialogue of what makes people different from each other
- Overview of medical conditions that may cause differences
- Discussion of how to treat those who are different or with disabilities
